General Itinerary

5:00–5:30pm

- Gather time. Get your food, find a seat, get ready for the night.

5:30pm

- Start time. Open in prayer, share communion together. *Please don't feel pressured to take communion. It's not mandatory.*

5:30-6:30pm

- Bible Study. Feel free to ask questions, move around, get another plate of food, check on your kids, etc.

6:30-8:00pm

- Prayer and Worship. Feel free to worship God as you seem fit but do so without being a distraction to others.

8:00-9:00pm

- When we feel the Spirit is moving, we might go over our time. This is that allowance for God to move. We might feel done at 8:30 and other times we might not get done until 10pm.

9:00pm

- We try to close the night in prayer around this time, but feel free to come and go as needed.
